- Precision in documenting data results and report results to Field Trial Manager

- Maintain a strong famer rapport, as well as keeping communication open between startup/entrepreneurial companies and the famer.
- On-farm meetings with farmers to visit trial sites and communicate back to Field Trial Manager
- Promote AgLaunch as the leader in Ag-tech accelerators
- Support, where possible, all teams within the AgLaunch organization
- Attend field days and university meetings to stay abreast of new technologies
